Sir,

This is with reference to your letter dated 26.07.2010, on the subject noted above.


In this regard, I am directed to inform you that the matter with regard to consider M.Sc. and Ph.D. in Biochemistry can hold faculty position in department of Biochemistry in a medical college was considered by the Equivalence Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 9th & 11th November 2010 and it was decided as under :

"...the Committee is of the opinion that in a medical college where the primary duty is to teach medical graduates and medical postgraduates, a person with MD Biochemistry is the appropriate qualification. The committee is also aware of the facts of scarcity of MD Biochemistry to take up the faculty position in medical colleges. To meet the gap the following is required:

"In a medical college, faculty member be appointed with MD persons with Biochemistry degree. However, in case of non-availability of MD, M.Sc. and Ph.D. in Biochemistry can be appointed as Assistant Professor. For this, prior approval of MCI should be obtained in which the efforts made to attract MD Biochemistry be also mentioned. Such faculty with non-medical background will not be entitled to become Head of the Department. In no case, the non-medical faculty will exceed 30% of the total strength of the department."

This decision is being communicated after taking the approval of the Minutes of Equivalence Committee by the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India.

GENESIS

Genesis of AMBI (Association of Medical Biochemists of India)-

The National convention of Medical Biochemists was held on 27th & 28th April 1991. at Bangalore. Large number of members participated from all over the country. Dr Gopalakrishnan, Dr.C.Sitadevi, Dr.B.Sadasivudu, Dr. B.Praphakar Rao and many more advocated the justification and necessity of formation of such forum to protect the interest of Medical Biochemists. On 28th April 1991 the Association was inaugurated by late Dr. S.Gopalakrishnan.of Madras at IMA auditorium in Bangalore. Dr.S.Gopalakrishnan and Dr. V.Govindaraju were unanimously elected President & Hon. Secretary respectively.

The rules & By Laws of the association were framed and approved. The state chapters were also constituted. The aim & objective of the association are :-

a) To promote and advance Medical Biochemistry and allied sciences, and to promote the improvement of public health, diagnostic services, Medical education and research.

- b) To maintain the honour & dignity and to uphold the interest of Medically qualified Biochemists and to promote Co Operation amongst the members there of.
- c) To educate the public in the matter of public health and to promote public relationship.
- d) To devise a uniform policy and programme on the matters of common interest, such as Medical education, Medical Administration and statutory Medical Council.
- e) To associate for mutual recognition with International and National organizations.
